According to Hickey (2013), there is a lot of confusion regarding pedophilia because many people, including professionals, view them “under the same lens” (p. 163).

The notion as to what constitutes “evil” is unmeasurable and is often used as a misnomer for inappropriate behavior (Hickey, 2013).

Studies suggest that there is a higher concordance rate for adult identical twins and nonviolent crime (Bartol & Bartol, 2010). Thus, this may indicate that when individuals are related there is a greater chance that both will show a particular behavior condition.

Bartol and Bartol (2010) emphasize, however, that “further research is need on the relative influence of genes on gender differences in antisocial behavior” (p. 65).
