



## The Program

Project ACE is an accelerated and intensive English program created for:

- People with strong academic backgrounds that want to learn English for Academic Purposes.
- Foreign professionals or foreign technicians who would like to improve their English:
  - to pursue higher education in the US,
  - to continue a career in the US, or
  - to obtain professional licenses in the US
- People who are willing to invest time and effort in an academically rigorous program.

## The Application Process

Follow the instructions below in the order as described.

### General Public

- 1- Enroll at MDC (Miami Dade College) by going to the Admissions Office.
- 2- Take the Compass ESL test in Testing Services.
