

# Your MyMDC Account and Your LINCCWeb Account: *Know the Difference!*

## MyMDC Account

Your **MyMDC Account** is an account you create for yourself that allows you to use computers on campus, register for classes online, print your schedule, etc. (If you have not yet set up your MyMDC account, go to <http://www.mdc.edu/current>, or visit the Kendall Campus Library Reference Desk on the second floor of building 2.)

Once you have created your MyMDC Account, you will have:

- a system-generated **username** that looks something like this: **Joe.Student001**
- a self-assigned **password** (at least 6 characters)

***Don't forget your MyMDC username and password!***

## LINCCWeb Account

Your **LINCCWeb Account** allows you to see what library materials are currently checked out to you, renew your books online, and log into the [LINCCWeb databases](#) to find articles and other information. Your LINCCWeb Account consists of:

- a **Borrower ID**, which is your MDC student number
- a **PIN**, which is the last 4 digits of your MDC student number

## Which account do you need when you come to the library?

**BOTH!!**

- You need your **MyMDC Account** to use a computer in the library.
- You need your **LINCCWeb Account** to use LINCCWeb features such as logging into databases.

You also need your MDC Card to check out library materials and to use the library's printers, so be sure to **bring your MDC Card with you**. (If you don't have an MDC Card, visit the Kendall Campus Student Life Office in room 102.)
