



Begin Your Research @ the Kendall Campus Library

1. Decide upon your **topic** for research – what subject will you explore?
2. How much **information** will you need to find?
3. Which **sources** can you use?
 - a. Books
 - b. Magazine or journal articles in online databases
 - c. e-books
 - d. Internet

Your topic, the sources you choose and types of information you will need depend on your assignment. Your professor can give you guidance on what is expected for your research paper.

How will you find what you need?

Start with the web address for Kendall Campus Library. www.mdc.edu/kendall/library



- a. Choose **Find Books** and click **library catalog**. Search by subject keyword, author, or title keyword.



- b. Click **Find Articles** and search for **articles** on your subject using LINCCWeb Databases. Use your 9- digit Student I.D. number and four -digit pin to access the Databases.



- c. Choose **Web Resources** to read **e-books** online. Click “E-Books and Digital Resources”.

- d. Link to  under **Quick Links** to search the Internet.
