S.O.A.P. REQUIREMENTS

Standards of Academic Progress (SOAP) is not designed to penalize or discourage students; instead the overall objective is to improve the performance of students experiencing academic difficulty. New SOAP guidelines effective at the end of summer term 2003-3 require that students **must maintain a 2.0 grade point average and earn at least two-thirds or 67% of the total credits for which they have registered**. For example: If a student has registered for 30 credits, they must earn at least 20 of those credits, which is 67% of the 30 credits.

Students experiencing academic difficulty may find themselves no longer in *Clear Academic Standing*. Experiencing academic difficulty **may affect financial aid eligibility**. Students should meet with a Financial Aid Advisor for clarification.

Students earning a restrictive SOAP category will have to see an academic advisor to develop an individualized educational plan to address their academic difficulties. Students **also will be limited in the amount of credits for which they may register each term**. SOAP students **also are required to register and successfully complete a mandatory Student Support Seminar (SLS 1125)** designed to help students be more successful academically by focusing on academic performance in a learning environment.

When earning a restrictive SOAP category due to low GPA, the student must increase the GPA to 2.0 or above. When earning a restrictive SOAP category due to earned credit, the student must earn the term credits registered and check with an advisor before withdrawing from any courses.
